Personal skills involve readiness to engage effectively with the community and follow through on commitments. Experience of committees, negotiation with different state and federal departments. Able to manage and understand financial statements and be aware of budget restraints.

Of particular interest is:

- Appropriate development for Pindimar/Bundabah/TG/HN and NAC. Building of new dwellings will occur but must be in keeping with the surrounds. Address anomalies in building approvals.
- Examine low-cost housing options to provide for essential workers eg. medical staff (ambulance officers, nurses, doctors, health support staff), hospitality staff to drive tourism for local businesses. One suggestion is to use some of council's land and build modular housing which could be removed later.
- Dredging the Myall River to allow continued use by ferry operators and tourists.
- Management of erosion on Jimmy's/Winda Woppa beach. Clearly sand transfer is not working. Other states have used different solutions eg. giant sandbags, with success. It's time to explore other options rather than a quick fix.
- Preserve the environment as this is what attracts people to move here and tourists to visit. We have two marine parks that need to be protected from proposed offshore wind farms. Yes, to renewables but not at the cost of the environment.
